Acceptable Attire:

- Dresses encouraged—strapless or halter style ok; Pant suits ok
- Hem length must be at least to the tip of the fingernails OR LONGER!
- No midriff (stomach, sides, or lower back) showing. No plunging necklines or nothing too revealing. **IF YOUR DRESS IS TOO SHORT OR TOO REVEALING, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE DANCE—NO EXCEPTIONS, NO REFUNDS!**
- Collared dress shirt; Tie or Bow Tie encouraged/Jacket optional
- Dress pants, slacks, or nice khakis
- Dress shoes encouraged/Nice sandals ok
- No torn or ripped clothing; No jeans, hats, or flip-flops

ATTENTION PROM ATTENDEES:

The Security Staff wants you to have a good time at the dance. In order to help you with this, we have a few guidelines:

1. Everyone must show a current BHS ID card and a prom ticket. Get there early to avoid long lines!
2. You must enter the prom by 9:30pm. If you leave for any reason you will not be allowed to re-enter.
3. Do not bring valuable items to the dance unless you can hold them on your person. Staff, security, and/or chaperones will not be responsible for lost or stolen items and they will not hold your belongings for you.
4. Suggestive or vulgar dancing is not allowed. If you are dancing inappropriately, you will be asked to leave the dance. No refunds!
